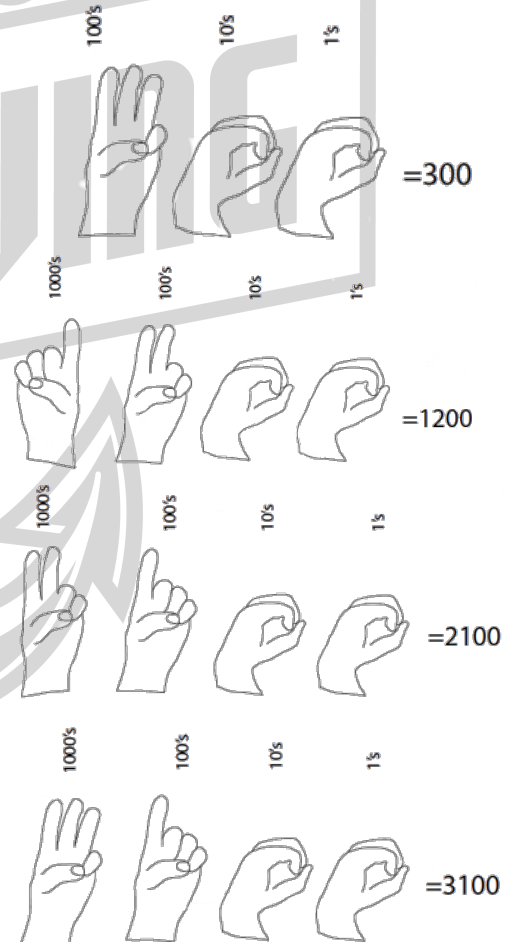
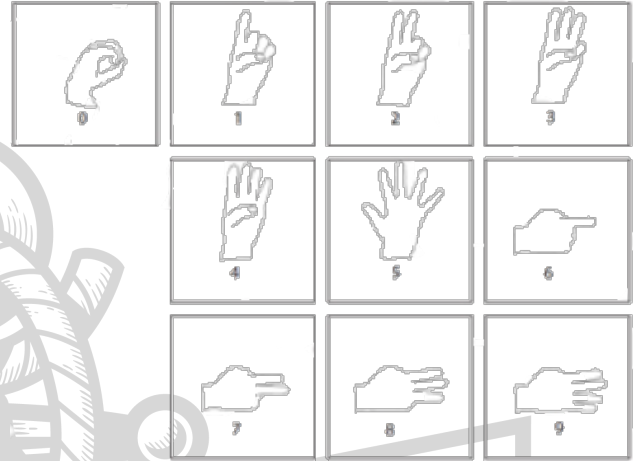
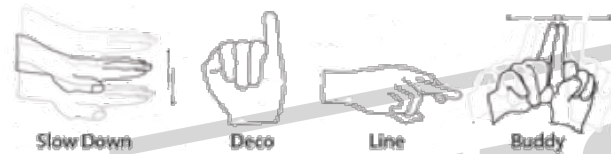
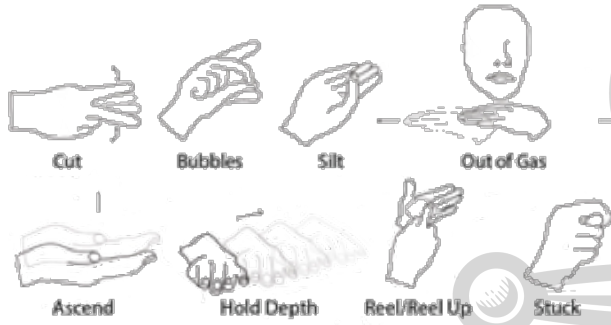




Handsignals

Okay

A circular light pattern indicates that a diver is okay and at the same time asks the other team members if they are okay. Divers must respond with a corresponding light circle or with a back and forth motion if something is wrong.



Attention

To gain the attention of one's team members, a diver moves his light slowly back and forth, or up and down. Once this signal is detected, hand signals may be used to convey additional information.



Immediate Attention

A rapid back and forth or up and down motion with the light indicates the need for immediate attention. Team members must immediately respond, seek additional information, and provide assistance if necessary.
